2025 Report to the Community: July 1, 2024—June 30, 2025

Responding to the needs of our community is the cornerstone of our mission at Opportunity House. This year, we took bold steps to address homelessness in our community. Here are the highlights:

Opportunity House provided services to **353** individuals, families and veterans while completing renovations throughout the campus.

**165** students who attended the Second Street Learning Center throughout the year.

The Pottstown Shelter at the Days Inn opened to serve individuals displaced by the removal of a railroad encampment. We helped **187** clients rebuild their lives.



Construction of the Patton Avenue Learning Center was completed at the Oakbrook Homes providing affordable childcare for working parents.

Children from six weeks old through kindergarten now receive Keystone Star-quality education Monday through Friday.

Our OppShop and Warehouse diverted **1,016,000** pounds of materials from landfills while providing affordable clothing and household goods for our clients and the community.



Affordable housing remains a top priority, as it offers the greatest potential to reduce homelessness. From parents to Veterans and individuals with disabilities, our permanent housing program provided safe, stable housing for **134** people.

Our three PreK Counts classrooms graduated **38** children who were well prepared for their first day of kindergarten. Learning was fun for the

Volunteers are the heart of our organization providing approximately **7,500** hours of service. Our **162** cooking groups provided nearly 50 percent of the **96,575** meals we served at Opportunity House.

From Souper Bowl to Wine, Women and Shoes, and our Annual Golf Outing, volunteers helped us bring people together to fuel our mission of empowering individuals to improve their lives.

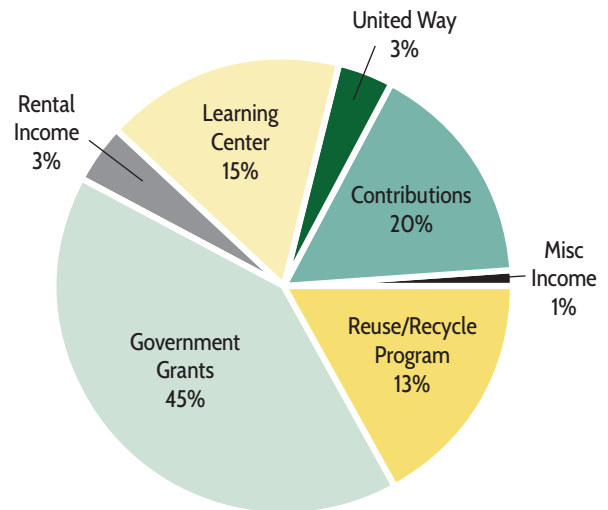

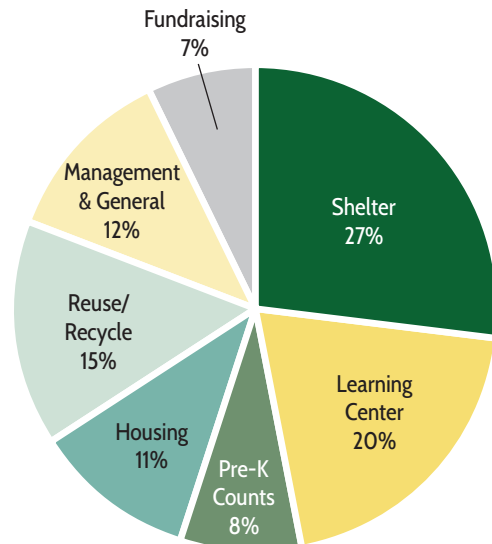
